When: Saturday, April 21, from 10:00 until 2:00 p.m. Picnic meal served at 12:00 noon.

Where: Woolly Hollow State Park, 82 Woolly Hollow Road, Greenbrier. (See photos on pages 2 and 3.)

Note: We have reserved the pavilion for a half day, 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. So, you may show up to enjoy the park as early as you like.

Who: All ACC members and your guests are welcome and encouraged to attend.

What: Picnic lunch and potluck meal. Hot dogs and hot dog rolls provided. Please bring your favorite picnic food, such as cold salads, chips, desserts, etc. Bill Smith will be serving his famous Razorback Red Hots—delicious beef hot dogs with meat sauce.

If you love hot dogs, you'll enjoy Bill's Razorback Red Hots speciality.

Other: Please bring your lawn chairs and coolers with cold drinks.

Directions: Take Exit #125 off I-40 at Conway and travel 12 miles north on U.S. 65, then go six miles east on Arkansas 285 to the park.

Again, we reserved the pavilion for a half day, (8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.) and we plan to serve the picnic meal at 12:00 noon.

There is no specific set time to arrive for the picnic. ...so we'll look for

you any time in late morning or early afternoon.

Please plan to join fellow Arkansas Corvair enthusiasts at Woolly Hollow State Park, on Saturday, April 21, to enjoy food, fellowship, and Razorback Red Hots, and to spend a spring afternoon in the Ozark foothills.

Old Business

We continued the discussion begun at the February meeting concerning a spring social event.

A launch ramp is located on Lake Bennett. The park offers canoes, kayaks, pedal boats, fishing boats and motors for rent, and a launch ramp.
