As the son of charter ACC members Stew and Ronnie MacLeod, Ryan truly has the Corvair hobby coursing through his veins. ■

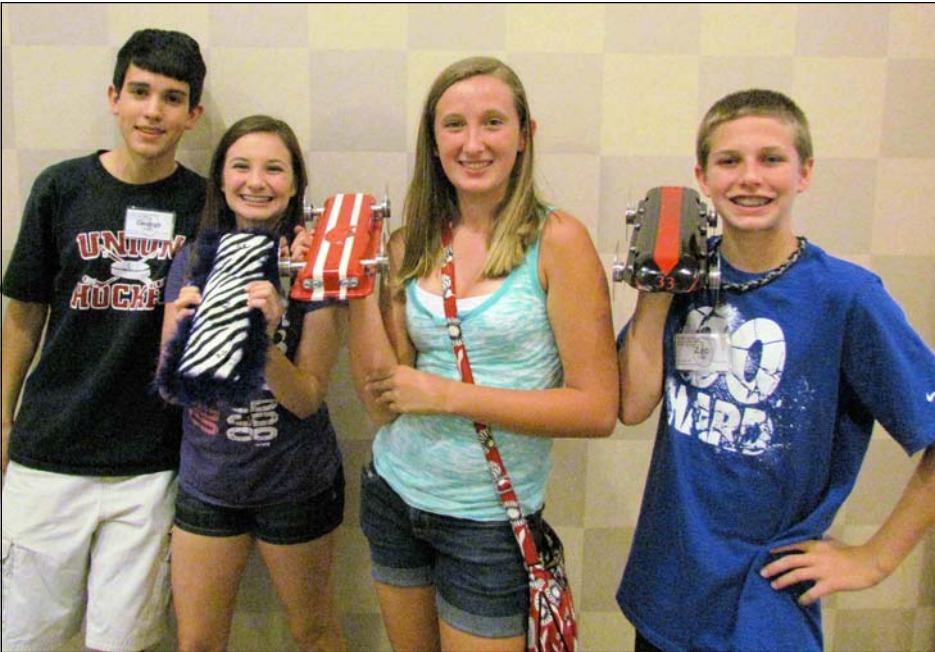

Keith reported that the July CORSA convention, in Denver, was an enjoyable and successful experience for all ACC members who attended.

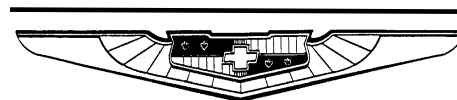
